# Show Stompers Spotlight Rules & Policies

## **General Rules:**

- Costumes must not feature lose glitter, excessive nudity, or profane language.
- There is no theme for the Step Show; each group is responsible developing their own show
- Each routine may consist of any combination of skits, dance, and/or steps.
  However, each routine should have stepping for at least 50% of the routine time.
- No free-standing props will be allowed unless they do not represent a safety hazard to the participants on the stage. (This does not include chairs\*\*).
- No use of fire, pyrotechnics, or other hazardous materials/objects.
- No props that resemble any type of firearms will be permitted under any circumstances.
- There is no jumping off the stage.
- Each team must perform for at least 7 minutes but no longer than 15 minutes.
  There is 1 minute allotted for the set up transition. Clock will start upon the first sign of the beginning of a competition act.
- Music must be radio edits (no cursing, no overtly explicit material) and should be submitted to rit.pandemic.step@gmail.com no later than November 12th, 2021.
- No profanity/explicit content is to be allowed within any portion of the show/performance.

### **POLICIES:**

- Teams may consist of 3-15 members with two additional members allowed as "stagehands" or assistance, if needed.
- Fraternities and sororities can form teams if the team does not exceed 15 participants
- No defamation of character is to be tolerated, on stage or off stage. This includes defamation on the basis of gender, ethnicity, religion, sexual preference/lifestyle, economic status, etc. This also includes inappropriate conduct and/or unprofessionalism exuded on and off stage toward other competition teams or audience members
- Each team will be allotted time to practice on stage before performance if desired.
- Each team mist agree to Rules & Policies in order to participate
